Football/Safety Guidelines for Tailgating

The University wants tailgating to become a tradition at the University of South Alabama. We want everyone to enjoy all the good things that tailgating has to offer while at the same time using good judgment that will result in a safe and secure environment for all concerned.

1. Grilling should not be done within 50 feet of a building. All fires should be contained within grills or other containers designed specifically for that purpose. No open pit fires will be allowed.
2. Grilling or other outdoor fires should be thoroughly extinguished with water before being left unattended. Burning fires or hot coals should never be left unattended. Do not dump coals on the ground; put all coals in designated drums.
3. To maintain access routes for emergency vehicles, never park in roadways, in front of fire hydrants or in areas marked "No Parking".
4. Grounds should be kept clean by bagging trash and properly placing trash in receptacles. Keep combustibles such as paper, card board, etc. separated from flammables.
5. To minimize dangers of carbon monoxide poisoning caused by engine exhausts, recreational vehicles and trailer owners should insure there is adequate space between vehicles. Install carbon monoxide detectors if possible.
